Membership applications can be mailed at any time. You cannot enter any rodeo until your **ORIGINAL** application is received in to me, and complete with all the requirements. **FAXED APPLICATIONS ARE NOT ACCEPTABLE.** You can check the website and the Cowboy's Digest for the "Membership Card Must Be Complete By" date for each rodeo.

Fill out both sides of the membership application completely (membership application and the Minors Release). The application is a fillable form, so you can type in your information, print it off, and then have it notarized.

FRONT:

- Fill in personal information.
- Include your email address.
- State/Province Dues are \$15, which includes a subscription to the Cowboy's Digest. Total membership is \$95.
- Initial the blank in the **"Important – Please Initial"** box.
- Check the events you wish to participate in throughout the rodeo season. **As per the Membership Application, members are eligible to enter any event for their gender. Checking the events is for statistical purposes only.**
- **CONTESTANT** must sign and date the form at the bottom.
- **BOTH PARENTS** and/or guardians must sign form at the bottom. If parents are divorced, and one has sole custody, write "divorced – sole custody". If both have partial custody, both have to sign. If a parent is deceased, write "deceased" on the line.

BACK: (Minor's Release)

- Fill in personal information on the top of the form.
- **ALL** (member and both parents) signatures **MUST** be witnessed with a notary's signature. (Unless a parent is deceased, or is divorced with sole custody. In that case write "Deceased", or "divorced – sole custody". If parents are divorced and both have partial custody, both have to have their signatures notarized.
- **The notary MUST WRITE ALL THREE NAMES on the line following "personally appeared". This line is very important. This acknowledges that the notary witnessed all signatures.**

OTHER PAPERWORK:

- Include payment of your membership dues. Membership dues are \$95 to be paid by **CASHIER'S CHECK or MONEY ORDER ONLY**, made out to **MHSRA Jr. High**. No personal checks will be accepted. **DO NOT SEND CASH.**
- New members only, send a copy of your birth certificate.
- Send a copy of your semester grades. For Fall Rodeos - If you competed at the State Finals rodeo, I have your grades, and you do not need to send them. For Spring Rodeos – you will need to send in your fall 2017, semester grades.

If any of the above information is incomplete, or incorrect, your membership will not be accepted, and you will not be able to rodeo until the information is corrected.

Send all paperwork to Laurie Harrell, PO Box 264, Roy, MT 59471. My phone number is 406-464-2686 if you have any questions. As soon as your completed application is in, you are eligible to enter the rodeos. You can check your eligibility on the website, www.mhsra.com. Click on "Eligibility", on the top of the Home Page. There will be a list of High School and Jr. High Eligible Members, in alphabetical order. Your membership packet will be mailed out soon after.

ONLINE ENTRIES: Go to the "Online Signup" button on the top right-hand corner of the Home Page, select "Jr. High". Type in your name and your information will appear. Click on your name.

*When you enter online, you will receive a confirmation email. Keep this until after the rodeo is over. Online entries will be open 20 days before the phone entries for those rodeos. Only 1 partner can enter a team in the team roping and ribbon roping. The other partner must enter their other events.

* Phone entries are 2 Tuesdays before the rodeo(s), from noon until 2:00pm. Call Laurie Harrell at 464-2686 for phone entries for the Jr. High.

*The Online entries will be posted Tuesday morning before phone entries. Call at phone entry time if anything is incorrect. After phone entries, the pre-drawn rodeo will be posted on the website. Check and make sure your entries are correct. Click on "Rodeo Info" at the top of the Home Page, and then click on "Draw".

*Call Backs will be done on Thursdays, from noon until 2:00pm. Changes can be done at this time for the rodeo, or rodeos, that are being entered that week, or you can draw out. **If your entries are correct on the website, there is no need to call back.** If there is a mistake on your entry and you did not call back, your entry will stay as posted.

ENTRY FEES – Entry fees for the Jr. High are \$15 Timed Event, \$25 for Rough Stock, \$1 gate fee per event, plus, per rodeo, a \$3 Junior Division office fee, \$2 judges fee, and \$2.50 central entry fee.

HOME SCHOOL - Home school students must send their curriculum to Nicki Knerr, PO Box 96, Grass Range, MT 59032. Her phone is 406-670-0235, and her email is nickiknerr@wildblue.net. This service is at the cost of the prospective member. Memberships are not complete until I receive an official letter from Nicki Knerr. Realize that this takes time, so allow enough time for processing.

FALL RODEO SCHEDULE: Will be on the website soon.

VET OUT RULE CHANGE: Passed at the State Board Meeting in June. Anyone who wants to Vet Out of a rodeo will pay a \$30 per event charge, per rodeo, with \$20 going to the committee to cover Stock Charge, and \$10 going to MHSRA Jr. High. If fees are paid for both rodeos and the contestant needs to Vet Out the next day, said contestant has the option to have fees returned to them, but will still pay the \$30.00 Vet Out fee.

MINOR'S RELEASE, ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT

We, the undersigned, hereby request that the below named minor (minor) be granted permission (1) to enter the restricted area, (2) to participate as a contestant, assistant, official or otherwise in rodeo events, (3) to compete for money, prizes, recognition or reward, (4) to be covered by participants' hospitalization insurance, if applicable, as limited by the master policy (all collectively hereinafter called "permissive entry").

In consideration of "permissive entry" to minor into the restricted area, which is the area from which admission to the general public is restricted, which includes, but is not limited to the rodeo arena, competition area, chutes, pens, adjacent walkways, concessions, and other appurtenances, we, the undersigned, on behalf of the minor and for ourselves, our personal representatives, heirs, next of kin, spouses and assigns, do hereby:

1. RELEASE, DISCHARGE AND COVENANT NOT TO SUE the rodeo committee, stock contractor, rodeo association, sponsors, arena operators or owners, and each of them, their officers, agents and employees (all hereinafter collectively referred to as "releasees") from any and all claims and liability arising out of strict liability or ordinary negligence of releasees or any other participant which causes the undersigned injury, death, damages or property damage. We, the undersigned, jointly, severally, and in common, covenant to hold releasees harmless and to indemnify releasees from any claim, judgement or expenses releasees may incur arising out of any of the minor's activities or presence in the restricted area.

2. UNDERSTAND that minor's entry into the restricted area and/or participation in rodeo events contains DANGER AND RISK OF INJURY OR DEATH TO MINOR, that conditions of the rodeo arena change from time to time and may become more hazardous, that rodeo animals are dangerous and unpredictable, and that there is INHERENT DANGER in rodeo which we each appreciate and voluntarily assume because the minor and we choose to do so. Each of the undersigned has observed events of the type that the minor seeks to participate in. We further understand that the arena surface, access ways or lack thereof, lighting or lack thereof, and weather conditions all change and pose a danger to the minor. We further understand that other contestants and participants pose a danger to the minor, but nevertheless, WE EACH VOLUNTARILY ELECT TO ACCEPT ALL RISKS connected with the minor's entry into the restricted area and/or participation in any rodeo events.

3. AGREE that this agreement shall apply to any incident, injury, accident or death occurring on the above date and FOR A PERIOD OF TIME covering any statutory period in which a cause of action may accrue for minors or adults. All subsequent agreements and release documents signed by any of the undersigned shall amplify, but shall in no way limit the provisions of this document. The provisions of this document may be cancelled by any one of the undersigned by delivering to the above rodeo association written cancellation of this agreement which shall be effective 24 hours after the date said cancellation is actually received by the rodeo association.

4. Releasor or parents or guardians of the undersigned minor AGREE TO INDEMNIFY the Releasees and each of them from any loss, liability, damage or costs they may incur due to the presence or participation of the minor in the described activities whether caused by the negligence of the Releasees or otherwise.

WE HAVE READ THIS DOCUMENT, WE UNDERSTAND IT IS A RELEASE OF ALL CLAIMS. WE APPRECIATE AND ASSUME ALL RISKS INHERENT IN RODEO.
